

Temple Emanuel Sinai Regathering Policy

The board met on June 14, 2021 and decided upon the following policy regarding the reentry and regathering within the TES building. Guidelines may shift rapidly as conditions around the pandemic improve or deteriorate. We will pivot again as often as necessary.

Masks: Masks are still required when in the building. We must be respectful of all congregants and ensure the comfort of all as they come to the building. **If you are unable to wear a mask for any reason, you will have to wait until the mask requirement is lifted before entering the building.** Updates on this mask policy will be sent via the eNews.

Meetings: Once the office is fully open, small groups may meet in the building or outside; outside is preferable. Reservation of the space will have to occur as it did prior to COVID. The congregation will be notified once the office is fully open.

Office: The office staff will be allowed to work without masks while in the office space. They will put on masks when someone enters the building. We will be working with the new Business Manager to reestablish normal working hours in the office during July and will notify you when you may once again conduct business in person.

Vaccinations: We will not be requiring proof of vaccination for Temple activities. We request that you don't ask others about their vaccination status. **Everyone must wear a mask in the building until further notice.**

Services: You will be updated about services on a regular basis through the eNews. If you have questions, please call the office.

Remote Meetings: The Governor has signed legislation that allows for remote meetings of public bodies until April 1, 2022

Security: We ask that as you return to the building, you remember that Security is still a primary concern. The Keshers, trained by Mark Shear, are present at most services. We should all serve as eyes for the unusual or the out of place. Anti-Semitic attacks are still occurring and we must remain vigilant.
